*When riding the μSKY or first class cars on the limited express, a 360 yen surcharge (called a "μticket") is required in addition to the regular passenger fare.

*The prices in parentheses include the surcharge price (μticket: 360 yen per ride).

*Transit times listed apply to daytime trains.

※ Connections can be made from Nagoya Station to the Shinkansen bullet train, JR, Kintetsu, and Nagoya subway lines; and from Kanayama Station to the JR and Nagoya subway lines.

Getting On and Off the Train at the Airport



From Kanayama Station to Kanayama Hotel (about a 2-minute walk)

Meitetsu Railways: Exit the central ticket gate and turn right (towards the North Exit). Kanayama Hotel is on your right-hand side after exiting the North Exit.

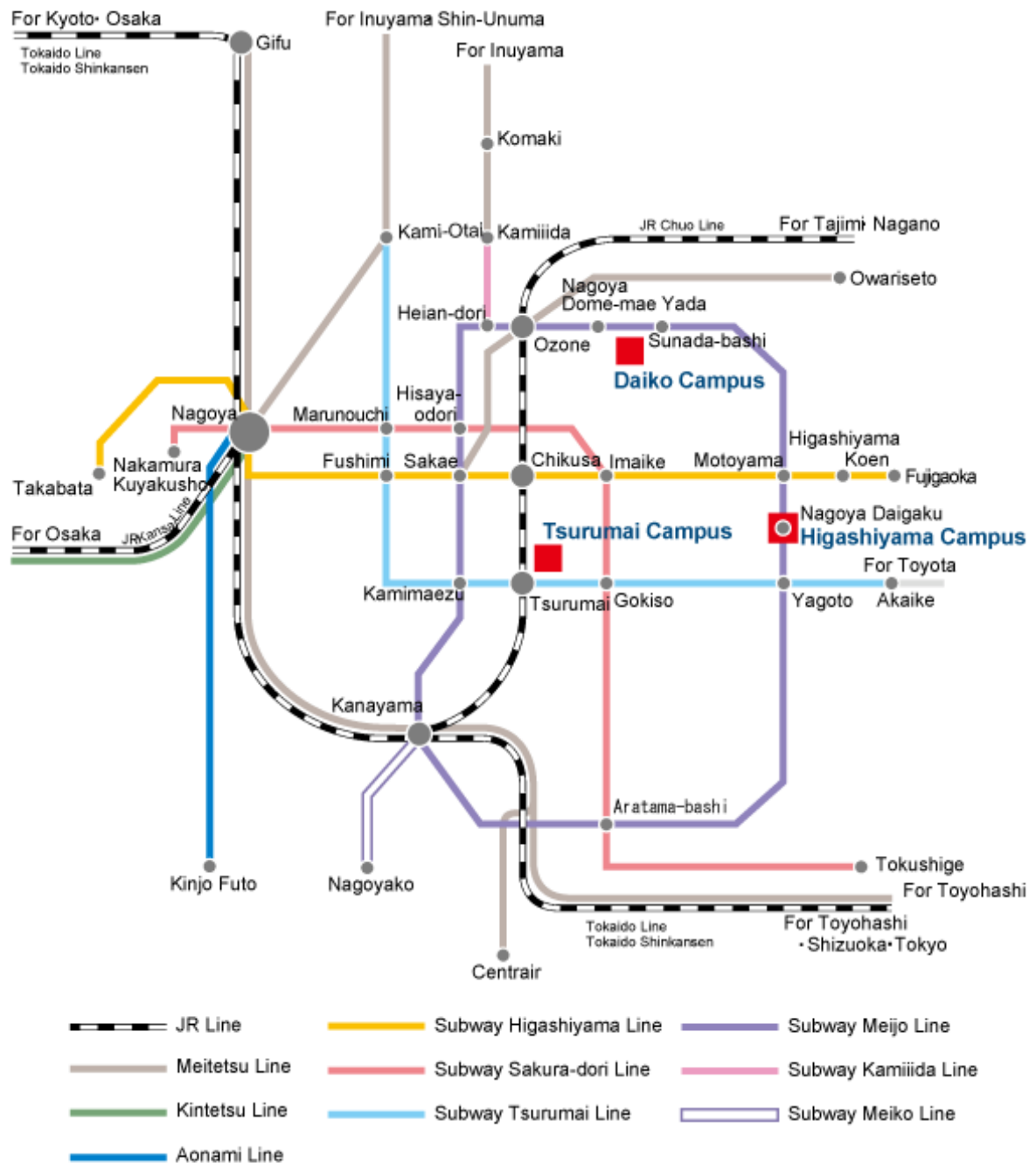
Subway: Kanayama Hotel is in front of Exit 3.

JR: Exit the ticket gate and turn left (towards the North Exit). Kanayama Hotel is on your right-hand side after exiting the North Exit.



From Kanayama Station to Nagoya University

At Kanayama Subway station, take Subway Meijyo Line to Nagoya Daigaku Station (Nagoya University Station). (21 min.).



Access from Narita (Tokyo) airport to Nagoya, ground transportation

From Narita to Kanayama, you will need two train exchanges. First please come to JR Tokyo station by taking NEX and then transfer to Tokaido Shinkansen to Nagoya, then transfer to JR chuo like to Kanayama.

On arrival at Narita airport, please proceed to the JR train station which is located on the basement level and is directly connected to the airport. Please make sure that the train station is for “JR” instead of the Keisei which is another train service.

At the ticket office near the JR gate, please purchase two kinds of tickets. One is for boarding ticket. Please tell the clerk your final destination (Kanayama (金山) Station). Another one is for express ticket. The easiest way to go is to take a NEX (Narita EXpress) to reach to the JR Tokyo Station. Please purchase the NEX ticket if you wish. Sometimes local train can arrive at Tokyo Station earlier since the NEX is not so frequently operated. Please ask the clerk for the earliest arrival. You can also purchase seat reservation ticket for Tokaido-Shinkansen here but you can do so later once you arrive at JR Tokyo Station. This is safer since you will miss the reserved train if the NEX arrived behind the schedule or you may take a longer time to transit at Tokyo Station than expected (as Tokyo station is physically large).

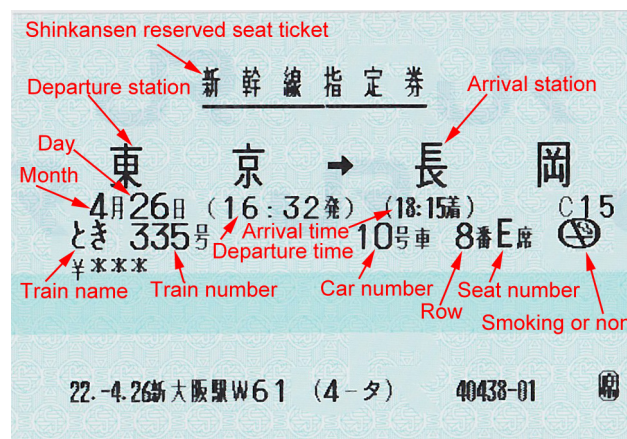
Arrived at Tokyo Station, please go to the Tokaido-Shinkansen connection gate (signed with blue colored train mark and number 14~19)



If you would like to purchase the Shinkansen ticket at Tokyo Station, please do so before entering to the Shinkansen-gate. Since you already have a boarding ticket, only you have to purchase is “seat reservation ticket”,

which costs 4,830 JPY. If you wish to ride with the first class car, please ask clerk “green car ticket” which costs roughly as double.

After purchasing all tickets, please go through the connection gate. You should insert both boarding ticket and reservation (or first class) ticket stacked in pairs to the gate. Check your reserved train and seat printed on the reservation ticket. Please refer to the figure below showing the example of how to read the reservation ticket. Train name should be “のぞみ”, arrival station should be “名古屋”. Please check the platform that your train departing from which is shown right after the entering the gate. You can find the car number plates once you come to the platform. If you have any trouble to find your train, please ask any of the train or station crews wearing either blue or gray uniform.



It will take about 100 minutes from Tokyo to Nagoya Station. Enjoy your 270km/s journey. After arrived at Nagoya Station, please proceed to the connection gate to the local JR train. Again please inset two tickets and pick up boarding ticket, ejected from the front side of the gate. Please go to the platform either 7, 8, 10. Please check the earliest departure shown at the concourse. All of the train departing at this platform will arrive at Kanayama station with only one stop.

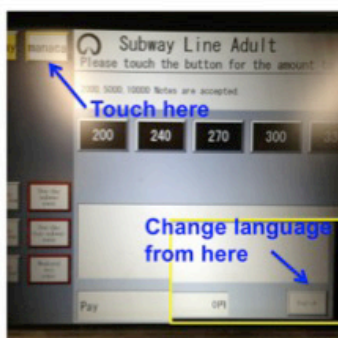
Train/subway tickets in Nagoya

We strongly recommend you to purchase an IC card 'manaca'. It can be used for almost all the public transportations include Meitetsu train, JR train, Nagoya Municipal Subway and bus. This card can also be used for public transportation in Tokyo.

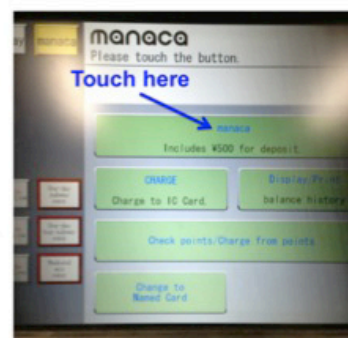
- How to purchase manaca



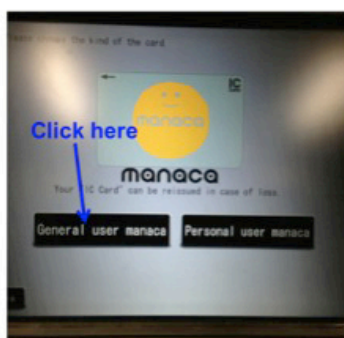
① Find a ticket-vending machine that has a 'manaca' mark at stations. Please make sure that machine has a 'New IC Card' label.



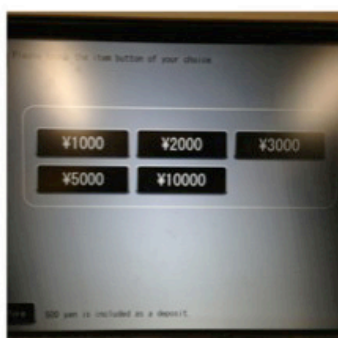
② Change language and touch 'manaca'



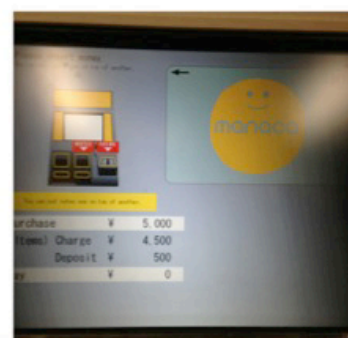
③ Touch 'manaca'



④ Touch 'General user manaca'

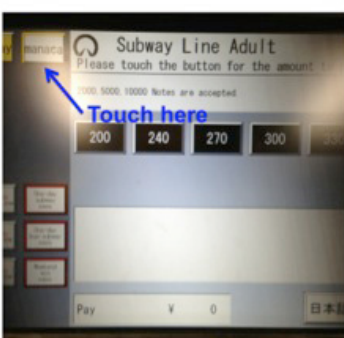


⑤ Choose the amount of money you want to charge on your card.

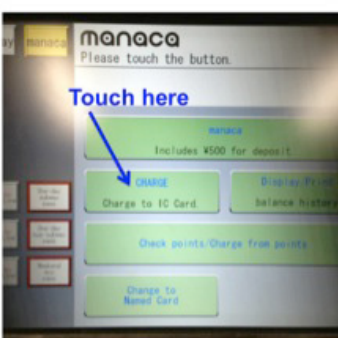


⑥ Insert the money, and retrieve your manaca card.

Machine dedicated for Recharging

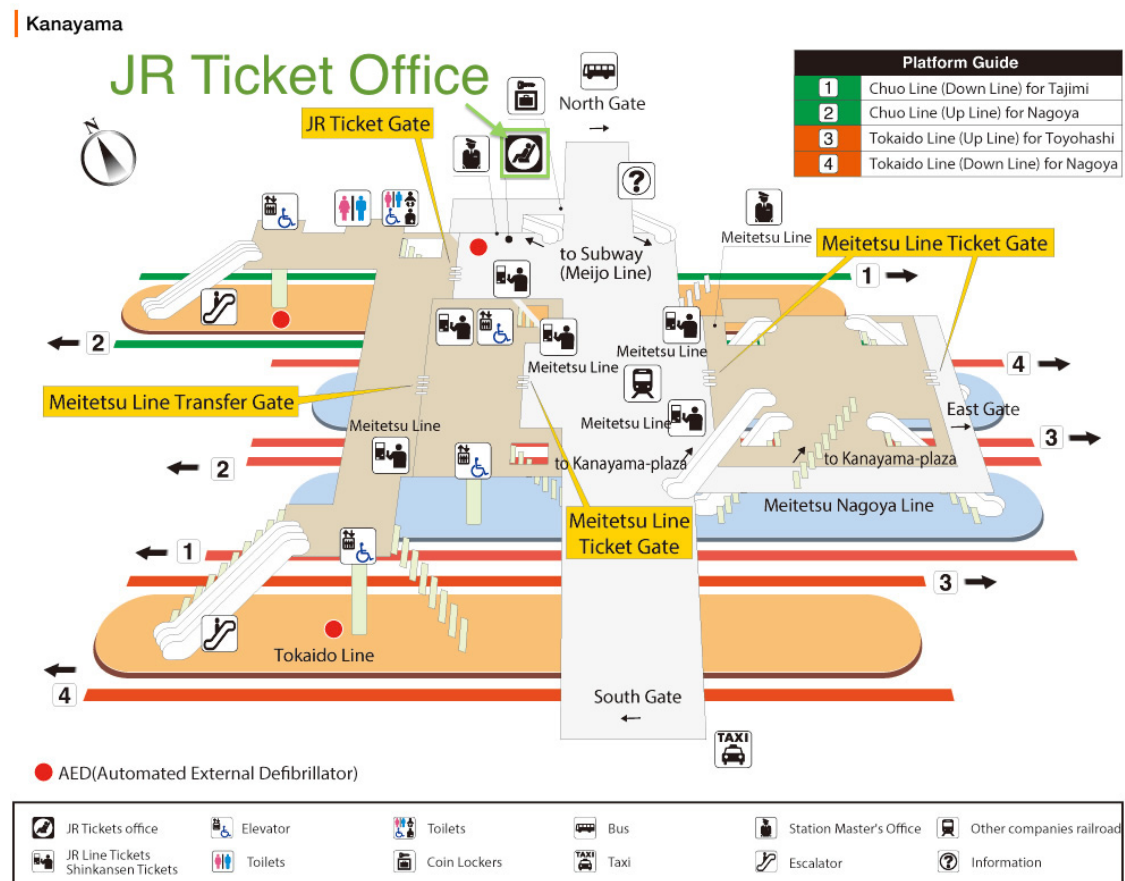
You can recharge money into your manaca card at any ticket-vending machine that has a 'manaca' mark.

When the manaca is no longer needed, the card can be exchanged for the deposit (500 yen) at any ticket counter.

If you want to take a first class car for traveling Centrair ⇔ Kanayama, you need to purchase a μ Ticket (360 yen) along with a railway ticket/manaca. You can purchase a μ Ticket at the ticket counter and the ticket vending machine. Please note that any credit card can NOT be used for ticketing and recharging for manaca.

Shinkansen Ticket to and from Tokyo

For attending the Waseda workshop, we will provide you with a shinkansen train ticket. You are free to go to Tokyo anytime on March 13 with that ticket. Before taking the shinkansen, please bring the ticket to the JR ticket office and make a seat reservation. If you skip the seat reservation, your ticket is only valid as a non seat reservation ticket. In that case, please take non seat reservation cars number one, two or three.



- Local people (Dr. Cai and Nishizawa) will organize group trips all the way to Tokyo (Rihga Royal Hotel). If you would like to join please come to a lobby of ANA CROWNE PLAZA. We will depart at 9:00 and 11:00. For more details, please see “Access to Rihga Royal Hotel” section.

Leaving for University on 6th and 7th morning from Hotel

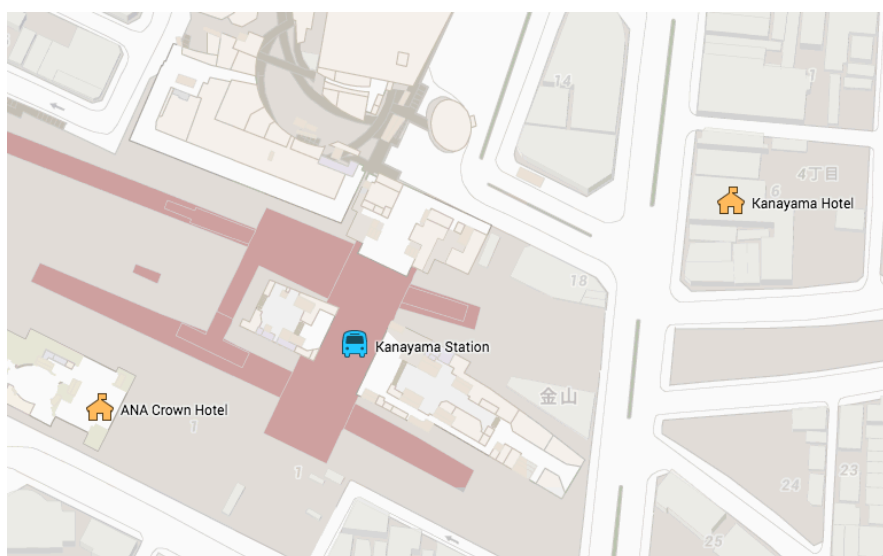
As the hotel is 20 minutes subway-ride distance from University, Dr. Dapeng Cai will lead the way to the University on the morning of March 6th and 7th.

On March 6th, we will leave "Kanayama Hotel" at 8:30. Dr. Cai will also help to buy subway ticket. Then the estimated arrival time is 9:20. The script workshop has been scheduled to begin at 9:30.

For those who need this help, please come to the Lobby of the Kanayama Hotel before 8:30.

On March 7th, we will leave "ANA CROWNE PLAZA" at 8:00. We are going to arrive at Sakata-Hirata Hall in the University 30 minutes before the workshop begins. For those who need this help, please come to the Lobby of the "ANA CROWNE PLAZA" before 8:00.

In the morning of the weekday, the subway is heavily crowded due to the commuting peak. If you would like to avoid the crowded train, please take the train departing before 7:45.

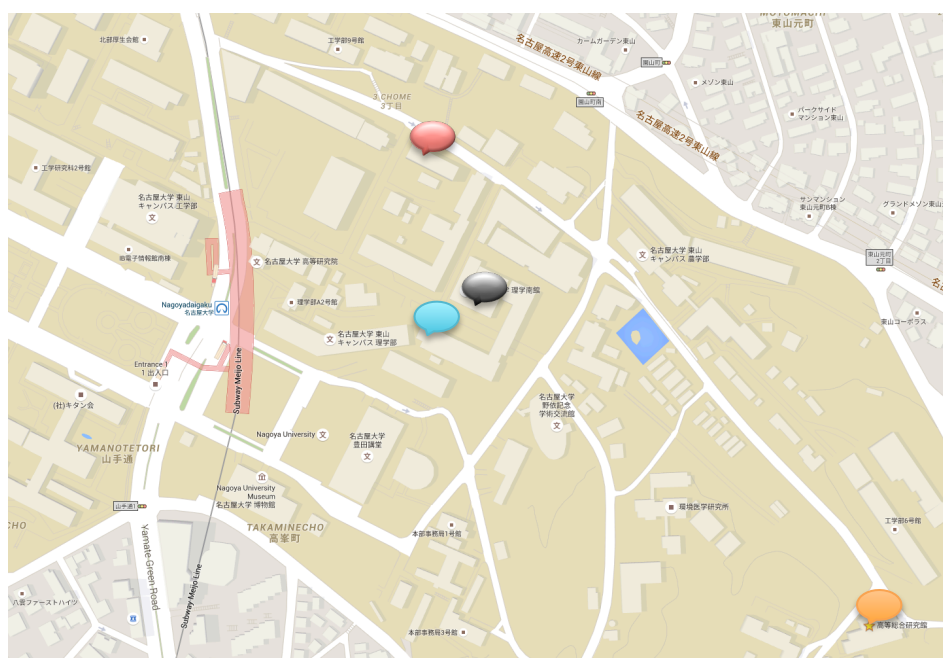

How to connect WiFi?

1) If you already have eduroam account, please find the SSID "**eduroam**" and connect with your ID and password. The eduroam is available over whole campus.

2) If you do not have eduroam, "**nuwnet**" can be used, which is as ubiquitous as eduroam. We provide the temporal user ID and password at the registration desk to connect the nuwnet. The temporal ID/PW will expire on March 12th. For those who need wireless connection after March 12, please be sure to pick up two sets of ID and password.

3) IAR LAN (SSID : **IAR_B5F**, PW : iarsince2002)

One can access only at Science Building B 5F. If you need to print documents, please connect to this network. The printing through eduroam and nuwnet is not available due to the network security policy of the University.

How to use printer?

We have a printer complex (DocuCenter-IV C2263) which can be accessed through LAN.

- 1) Make sure to connect wifi to IAR_B5F
- 2) Add network printer from your system preference.
- 3) IP address of the printer is **133.6.117.6**
- 4) select LPD protocol
- 5) Driver will be automatically selected and installed
- 6) For those who use older OS version of Mac, try to use preinstalled "FX Print Driver for Mac OS X v1.5"

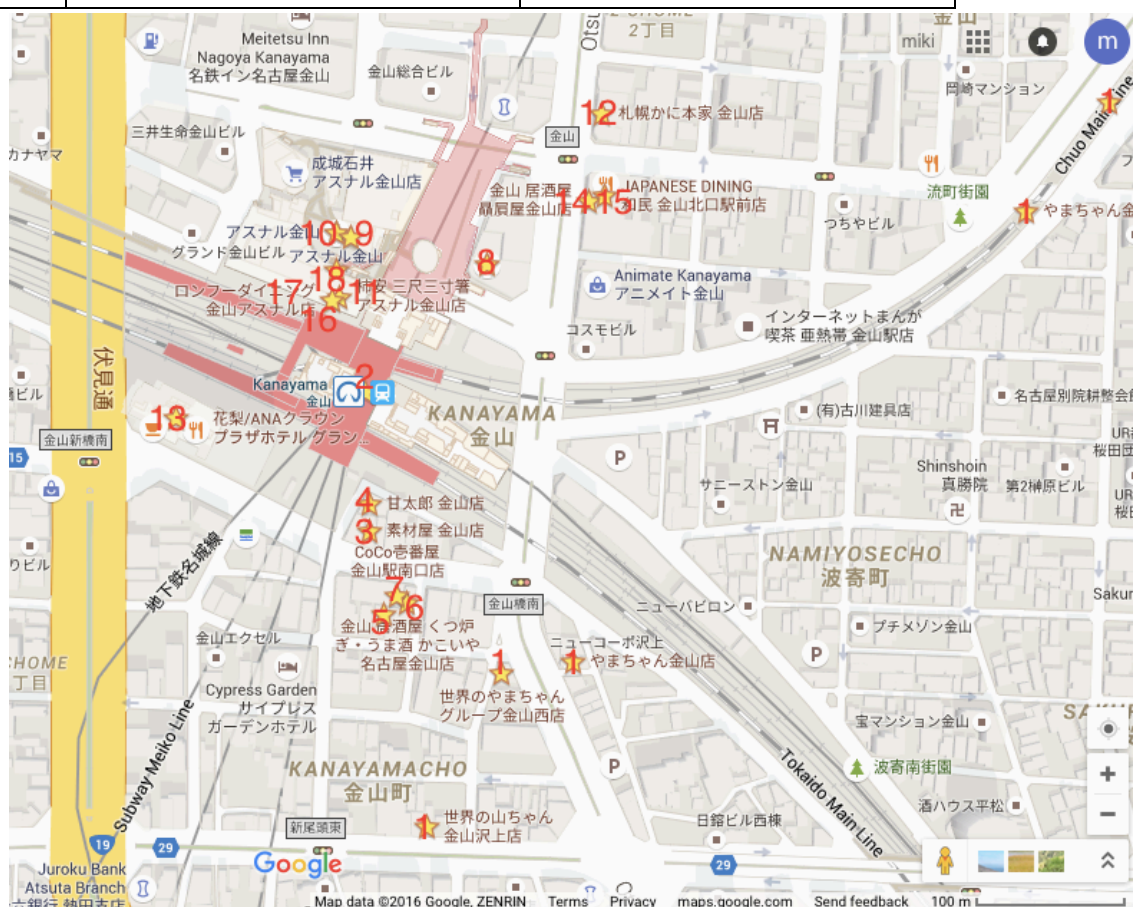

For Receptions and Banquet

Reunion Cocktail Reception on 6th

The reunion cocktail reception will be held at “Kisoji” a restaurant dedicated for Japanese cuisine and hot pod.

We will have two charter buses, one departing from Nagoya University (around subway station Exit 2), and another from ANA CROWNE PLAZA, at Kanayama. For both buses, the local organizers will escort you.

Access to the Yagoto-Koshoji Temple on 11th

We will have a workshop banquet at Yagoto-Koshoji Temple. The temple has been build 350 years ago and has a beautiful garden in it. You can also experience a “Zen mediation” there. We will have enough time to enjoy your visit before having a workshop banquet.

The temple is located near the subway Meijo line, Yagoto Station. Yagoto Station is about 5 minutes away from Nagoya University station by subway. Take clockwise train from Nagoya University, and walk west after getting off the subway at Yagoto Station (M20). Local organizers will escort you.



Introduction to Excursion : Explore the city of Nagoya (Mar. 12)

We will explore the city of Nagoya as the excursion event of this workshop. We take a bus and visit two museums which represent the history and industry of Nagoya. During the excursion, professional guidance will be available so that we can learn how the city of Nagoya has been developed from four hundred years ago to present.

First we will visit the "Toyota Commemorative Museum of Industry and Technology". Toyota is nowadays a world wide famous car company, but in its early stage, the company is for the looming machine. Sakichi Toyoda a founder of the Toyota Industry Co. Ltd. invented an automated looming machine and founded the company in 1926. The technology is applied and he expanded the project to produce cars. You can see the automated looming machines and many of the historical cars along with the history of the company at the museum.

Next we will move to the "Tokugawa Art Museum". Tokugawa has long dominated Japan for about two hundred years during the Edo era (1603-1867) and called as "Shogun", meaning a great general. During the Edo era, the capital is in Edo, current Tokyo, but the first Shogun, Ieyasu Tokugawa originated from Aichi area. After the Edo era, the 19th family head, Yoshichika Tokugawa established the Tokugawa Art Museum. The enormous amount of treasures are inherited but most valuable thing to see is "illustrated handscroll of the Tail of Genji", which is designated as the national treasure.

After visiting museums, we will have a lunch at "Koyo-en" a famous place for the beer hall in Nagoya.

Access to the Rihga Royal Hotel Tokyo on March 13th

We have a Waseda workshop on March 13th and 14th. March 13th will be devoted for travel to Tokyo. Any of you can freely move to Tokyo in your best convenience. However, the ticketing system for Shinkansen and using a public transportation in Tokyo would be a little headache.

For that reason, we will organize two group tours from ANA CROWNE PLAZA HOTEL in Kanayama to the Rihga Royal Hotel Tokyo as follows.

group 1) We will depart 9:00 AM at ANA CROWNE PLAZA HOTEL and arrive approximately at 12:00. Dr. Cai will lead the party. He will also assist to purchase the ticket. If you wish to join, please come to the hotel lobby before 9:00 AM.

group 2) We will depart 11:00 AM at ANA CROWNE PLAZA HOTEL and arrive approximately at 14:00. Dr. Nishizawa will lead the party. He will also assist to purchase the ticket. If you wish to join, please come to the hotel lobby before 11:00 AM.

Following is for those who would like to go by oneself.
From Kanayama station, take JR line to Nagoya Station. Ticketing machine is available around the transfer gate to the Shinkansen. Take Shinkansen (Nozomi is the best choice) heading to Tokyo. Get off the Shinkansen at Tokyo terminal, and go through the transfer gate to JR lines (you are already outside of gate of Shinkansen but still inside the gate of JR). At the concourse, head to the "Marunouchi" gate to finally exit to the ground. After that, please head to the Tokyo Metro Tozai Line, "Otemachi" station, which may take 15 minutes walk.

Take Tokyo Metro Tozai Line from "Otemachi" Station (T09) heading to "Nakano" and get off at "Waseda" station (T04). Exit 3a would be the most useful one at Waseda Station. Walk north to the direction of Waseda University. The Rihga Royal Hotel is located at the north edge of the Waseda University campus.

Please be aware that the last Shinkansen to Nagoya will depart 22:00 at Tokyo Station. For those who wish to return by yourself, do not miss that train and that there are two Shinkansen lines at Tokyo Station. One is Tokaido Shinkansen line, and the other is Tohoku Shinkansen line. You should take Tokaido line which is characterized by blue color (Tohoku line is characterized by green color).
